

In Science, we will be learning about animals including humans. We will learn how to classify animals, know about carnivores, herbivores and omnivores and identify the basic parts of the human body.

In History, we will be learning about significant people in history, with a focus on the life of Queen Elizabeth II and Edith Cavell, learning about their national and international achievements. We will be learning about events that are significant nationally or globally.

In Geography, we will look at our school and our local area. We will learn about human and physical features, with a specific focus on the Warrington area. We will also learn about simple maps including keys.



In Maths, we will be focussing on addition and subtraction within 20, place value within 50 including multiples of 2, 5, and 10, measurement: length and height and measurement: weight and volume.

In PE, we will be focusing on inclusive sports and outdoor adventurous activities. We will learn about working with others, developing our coordination and a range of skills.

In DT, we will be learning about food. We will look at healthy foods and a balanced diet. We will also learn how to prepare food safely as we make healthy snacks.

In Phonics, we will continue to learn about phoneme grapheme correspondence with a focus on alternative spellings for the same phoneme.

In Writing, we will be using the quality text 'Hermelin' to write a detective narrative and write letters. After half term we will look at 'Where the Wild Things Are' to write our own story and also write a recount. Throughout all of this we will focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar.

In PSHE, we will be learning about what helps us to stay healthy and what we can do with money. We will also be continuing learning about how our brains work using My Happy Mind.

In Art, we will look at the work of Pablo Picasso, Henri Matisse and Eric Carle. We will learn about a range of collage and texture techniques.

In Music, we will be exploring pitch, tempo, timbre and dynamics through a range of movements, singing and playing musical instruments.

In Reading, we will look at a variety of texts including familiar texts, recommended texts for Year One and text by Giles Andreae and Jill Murphy who are our termly authors.

In Religious Education, we will focus on Islam. We will learn about the Muslim belief of Allah as creator, Muhammed (pbuh) was a prophet and learn that humans should be caretakers of the planet.

In Computing, we will be using Beebots to learn about programming and then using laptops to learn about word processing.
