Curriculum Overview Year 1 Summer Term

In Maths, we will be focussing on position and direction, learning how to describe direction including turns. We will learn to tell the time to the hour and the half hour, we will also learn the days of the week and months of the year. We will then move onto place value beyond numbers to 20, we will also learn to count in 5s. After half term we will look at multiplication and division, money and measures.

In Writing, we will be using the quality text 'The Secret of Black Rock' to write a description and write stories. After half term we will look at 'The Last Wolf to write our own story and also write instructions. Throughout all of this we will focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar.

In Reading, we will look at a variety of texts including familiar texts, recommended texts for Year One and texts by Mick Inkpen and Tony Ross, our termly authors.

In Science, we will be learning about seasonal changes. We will observe changes across the four seasons observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.

In History, we will be learning about significant people, places and events linked to Warrington. We will learn about Roy Chadwick, Walter Senior and we are looking forward to learning about the RAF Burtonwood airbase.



In PE, we will be focusing on athletics. We will focus on Usain Bolt and explore what made him a great athlete. We will learn to sprint, accelerate and how to be safe in running.

In DT, we will be learning about free standing structures. We will look at existing structures, design our own thinking carefully about the materials selected.

In PSHE, we will be learning about what helps us to stay healthy and what we can do with money. We will also be continuing learning about how our brains work using My Happy Mind.

In Art, we will look at the work of William Morris. We will be creating our own observational drawings.



In Computing, we will complete some programming and coding using Scratch Jnr on the IPADs. We will continue our E Safety work to ensure we are always safe online.



In Religious Education, we will focus on Hinduism. This unit gives children the opportunity to explore the Hindu concept of one God (Brahman) who can be understood and visualised in many forms After half term, we will focus on Christianity and ask the question, how might some people show they belong to God?

In Geography, we will be identifying seasonal and daily weather patterns in the UK. This will run alongside our learning in Science, to observe changes across the four seasons and observe and describe the weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.

In Phonics, we will continue to learn about phoneme grapheme correspondence with a focus on alternative spellings for the same phoneme.

In Music, we will be exploring sounds. We will learn to sing the song, 'Your imagination'. We will learn to play the chime bars to this song.
