

# Curriculum Overview Year 2 Spring Term

**In Maths,** we will be covering units about money (recognising/shopping with a mix of coins and not multiplication and division (using known facts of 2/5/10/3 counting pattern length and height (using standard units) and mass, capacity and temperature (using standard units).



**In Writing,** we will be using the quality text 'The Bog Baby' to write some narrative and instructions and then we will move onto the text 'Grandad's Island' to write some narrative and create an information text. We will build on our prior grammar knowledge and will focus on different punctuation marks.



**In Reading,** we will continue our journey with the CODE X books, practising reading fluently and expressively. There will be more of a focus on written reading comprehension tasks this term also.



**In Religious Education,** we will focus on Hinduism – How might people express their devotion? Next we will focus on Islam – Why do Muslims believe it is important to obey God?



**In Science,** we will be learning about 'Living things and their Habitat' with a focus on naming different habitats, understanding what a micro-habitat is and how animals obtain their food including food chains.


**In PE,** we will be practising multi-skills indoor and then adventurous activities outdoor.



**In History,** we will be learning about 'The Great Fire of London' with a focus on understanding that England was ruled by a king, London is a settlement and changed after this event happened and about Samuel Pepys eyewitness account in his famous diary.



**In DT,** during spring 2, we will be creating textile related product using a pattern and different joining techniques.



**In Art,** we will look at the work of Andy Goldsworthy (local artist), Richard Long (sculpture) and Frank Stella (sculpture). We will then make 3-D paper sculptures and weaving large pieces outside.



**In Geography,** we will be learning about Continents and Oceans with a focus on naming the 7 continents and the 5 oceans. Also understanding where hot and cold places are in relation to the equator and how to read maps using longitude and latitude.



**In Music,** we will be exploring pitch, timbre, tempo and dynamics through different musical genre and by playing the chime bars.



**In Computing,** we will be learning about how to use the internet to collect information and then we will move onto learning how to create algorithms. Alongside this, we will be learning how to stay safe online.
