Dear Parents and Carers.

As always at this time of year, we have much to update you on and also a lot of good news to share.

I start with a huge thank you to Friends of Callands who are working hard behind the scenes to plan lots of wonderful events for our children. They recently launched the Spooky Spoon competition and the winners are pictured below, they each won a spooky hamper, full of goodies.

This month, the children are enjoying trips and enrichment activities, as part of our wider curriculum offer. Reception children are already under way taking part in Forest School Sessions, being led by Mr Dutton. Year 4 will be having a Greek Workshop delivered in school and Year 3 will be heading off on a trip to Pooles Cavern. Year 2 children will be undertaking a local walk, to enhance their Geographical understanding and vocabulary.

This week we started the week by marking Anti-Bullying Week, looking at the theme of 'Respect.' We have looked

at the definition, causes and effects of bullying and discussing anti-bullying strategies and procedures. We have spoken to the children about what makes a good friend and how we can be a good friend to everyone at school. 




Gymfinity Greatness
