Why you should PARK SAFE

As a driver you have a responsibility to stop and think about whether you are parking in a safe and considerate manner. If you are not you could be endangering a child's life

By ignoring parking restrictions you cause a hazard to other road users, pedestrians and cyclists. A parking fine will be issued by traffic wardens or police officers if you park illegally or cause an obstruction.

Don't park on zig zag lines

These protect school entrances leaving a clear view of the street for pedestrians



Don't park on yellow lines



They are there to prevent parking in dangerous places or causing an obstruction Cut pollution in the school environment and switch off your engine when parked



You can be fined for obstruction if you park on pavements or verges causing pedestrians to walk in the road



It is dangerous to let your child out of the car in the middle of the road



You can be fined if you park across a driveway restricting access for the homeowner
